Licentiate Diploma ruling for Part 2

Ruling for Part 2 Licentiate Diploma applications, specifically for those who have completed part 1 under the old rules and now wish to commence Part 2. The cost for Part 2 will be \$400.00. A 200 word synopsis is to be handed to the Mentor for approval before commencing the paper. Mentors must also sign off on papers before submitting to the National Office.

Candidates who are currently completing Part 2 on the old Licentiate Diploma system will have 2018 to complete the qualification or they revert to the new Rules and must restart.

Enrico Cecchetti Diploma

Candidates of the Enrico Cecchetti Diploma are allowed to do the required pirouettes en pointe later in the examination when the candidate changes in to stronger shoes. This information will be added to the Guidelines for the Enrico Cecchetti Diploma.

8th Port de Bras

The arms pass through a low 5th en avant similar to the position for pirouettes. The important point is that the head and eyeline should not be lowered but should remain looking over the arms. This was demonstrated at the Teacher Refresher Courses and has been incorporated in to the relevant syllabi.

Professional Teaching Package

The revised Professional Teaching Package is now known as Suggested Guidelines for the Associate Status Examinations.

Dance Spectrum 1&2

The pathways and body direction questions and the improvisation have been removed from these exams.

Candidates doing the Dance Spectrum 1 will be asked to select two tracks from the Dance Spectrum 1 CD Tracks for Choreography. The tracks are to have different time signatures and

candidates are required to choreograph solos to their choice of music prior to the examination and present it to the examiner in place of the improvisation.

Dance Spectrum 2 candidates will be asked to select one choreographer from the following list and research their life and give a brief talk on their chosen choreographer and one of the ballets they choreographed.

Choreographers

Marius Petipa

Sir Frederick Ashton

Graeme Murphy, A.M.

Note: this has been introduced in 2018.

Rules regarding the 'assisting students' in the Associate Diploma Part 1

Ideally the 'assisting students' for this exam should do their examination prior to assisting in the status exam.

However, in extenuating circumstances the students may take part in the Associate Diploma exam although this is not recommended. However, the students must be working on and being examined in the level of the Associate Diploma's class NOT the level above, for example if the Associate Diploma class is at Grade 5 then the assisting students should be prospective Grade 5 candidates for their own examination.
